APTLD Meeting

歸納出此次二天會議的主要議程內容,主要包括 IDN ccTLD 目前的進展與 有意申請 IDN ccTLD 的國家目前的準備狀況與進行的程度。同時因針對 IDN 相關的問題,也特別邀請 John Klensin 就 RFC 1591 進行 ccTLD 角色 的說明。除了 IDN ccTLD 的報告外,Edmon Chung 也針對 New gTLD 進 行說明與 GNSO 對 New gTLD 開放的 度。

另外在網域名稱推廣的方面,這一次也特別由地主國 Philippine 向與會者報告了.ph在 地如何進行.ph ccTLD 的推廣工作。強調.ph 與.com 之間的主要差異性:地域國碼的識別及仍有取好名的機會。主要的媒體傳 管道是printing 及 radio,這部份的廣告方式,.tw 也曾在國內執行過類似的推廣方案。另外 WebCC 也針對域名行銷與價格服務等關係進行報告。

首先進行祕書處報告,此次原 GM Don Hollander 將離職,並由 Ramesh 擔任 GM 一職,在此次會議中也特別感謝過去幾年 Don 在 APTLD 所做出的貢獻。

 在年度預算報告中也再度引發 Membership fee band 的討論,雖然目前 並無新的 Model,但如何執行的問題上也仍需要再進一步的討論。
 以下有幾個不同意見的表達:

- Stafford Guest (.nu) favours compulsory fee levels: have to retain some regular income given the economic crisis.
- (Keith asked if a risk of people leaving the organisation due to not affording the fees – Stafford said it's a risk worth taking, as APTLD is delivering value for money.)
- Hiro Hotta (.jp) question: has the Board discussed temporary waiver or discount system for fees? KD: yes, but no consensus reached. Hotta-san proposes basically compulsory, but if a member wants a waiver or discount for the current year, they will lose voting rights but can remain a member of the organisation.

Formal Annual General Meeting

在正式的年度會議中,主要通過 Board 的選舉,並進行了 Constitutional Changes,修改如下:

- Clarification that ordinary membership is open to one of the IANA-listed Sponsoring, Technical or Administrative Contact for each ccTLD in the Asia Pacific region.
- 2. Allowing associate members who come from beyond the Asia Pacific region.
- 3. Clarification that members can choose their own fee bands, and are not obliged to select the band that corresponds to their number of registered domain names.
- 4. Changes the quorum requirement so that at general meetings the quorum would be eight ordinary members or half the membership whichever is the fewer.

5. Extending the time allowed to fill a vacant Board member position from 30 to 60 days.

在 Board Meeting 主要針對 APTLD Membership Fee Band 進行討論。 在今年度的 Workshop 的主題設計決定以 DNSSEC 及 IPv6 為主。另外也 因 APNIC 將於今年八月份於北京舉辦,在遵循會員大會討論會議場地選擇 的原則時,並考慮飛航時間,決定今年八月份同 APNIC 會議於北京舉辦 APTLD 會議。

另外對於 APTLD 的會員調查工作,決定仿 CENTRE 的方式,設計一份固定的問卷,採會員自動更新進行調查的方式進行,以有效縮短調查經費,並能彙集最新的會員在域名政策的最新狀況。

三、考察、訪問心得:

目前 APTLD 決定在今年的 outreach 與 workshop 的課程設計,以 IPv6 與 DNSSEC 為主,因為在我國 IPv6 的發展,可以說是在亞太地區名列前茅,

因此如果能在今年的相關課程中擔任講者會是能進行相關報告與分享,定能 在亞太網路社群中,獲得更進一步的網路發展的社群認同。

在 EAI 的測試與日後的實際推出符合標準的中文化 email 服務,勢必能將 中文網域名稱現階段技術上仍無法有效克服的中文化郵件問題解決,也因完 整的中文域名服務的提供,更增加網路社群的註冊使用意願。

目前在 APTLD 的會費繳交與 fee band 的設計,一直存在的許多的問題與 議題需要討論,在此次的 Board meeting 與 Member meeting 中也都是一個 被討論的焦點。如何建立公平合理與適 性的收費以維持 APTLD 的有效運 作,將會成為今年度 APTLD 的重點議題,而新任的 GM 與 Board 也將面 臨此一問題的討論與解決。




Report of the Chair – 2008

I am delighted to prepare this report to members and friends of APTLD covering activities during the 2008 calendar year and providing a vision for 2009.

Membership

In December, we welcomed our 36th ccTLD member (Nauru). This resulted in a more than doubling of our membership since the appointment of our first GM in mid-2006.



Meetings and Training



At the APTLD Members meeting in Taiwan in February we had excellent discussion on DNSSEC, security issues in general, and adventures in growing markets from several of our members. IDNs, as usual, also featured in the meeting – with some hallmark work presented by the Arabic Script community – which led to the establishment of the Arabic Script Working Group – which we are also supporting. We also celebrated our 10th anniversary.

In April we participated in the ICANN regional meeting in Dubai and the AfTLD meeting in Johannesburg. In both venues we shared what we were doing – and how – with particular emphasis on the ADRP Program.

In May we saw APTLD's largest gathering – ever! We had more than 110 people attend various APTLD workshops, seminars and meetings during a week of activities in Kuala Lumpur. We started with a very full two-day workshop on 'Attack & Disaster Response Planning'. This was conducted in partnership with ICANN and Delta-Risk – and was so well received that all four regional organisations and ICANN joined to run it again in Cairo in October and will run it again in Mexico in February 2009. We also heard from a panel of Anycast providers as well as a panel of registry



software providers. In addition, two workshops were run – one on policy development and the other on marketing your ccTLD.

In August we ran the ADRP Technical Workshop in Brisbane in cooperation with APNIC. The course was very well received and a similar workshop was held as part of the APNIC 26 meeting in Christchurch in September with another planned at the APRICOT meeting in Manila in February 2009. During September we were represented at the APNIC 26 meeting in Christchurch and at the CENTR meeting in Italy.

December was a tough month as our meeting in Hyderabad was cancelled after security disruptions in India resulted in a large proportion of participants and speakers cancelling.

Policy Development and Others

In February significant progress was made on the introduction of IDN ccTLDs at the ICANN meeting in Delhi. APTLD's initiative to have a Fast Track Implementation for IDN ccTLDs moved forward in India and came to fruition in Paris in June, when we saw the IDN Fast Track concept endorsed by the ICANN Board – a real coup for the political influence of APTLD and its members

In October we had the first glimpse of ICANN's draft IDN ccTLD Fast Track implementation plan. An APTLD position paper on this implementation plan was provided to ICANN.

Members' comments on the draft New gTLD Application Guidebook were also gathered and feedback was provided to ICANN.

A number of surveys were conducted during the year which provided us a comprehensive view of our membership. Key among the findings is that we are truly diverse in many areas. What we do have in common is a shared commitment to serve our communities well.

General Manager

I can't complete this report to members without saying thank you to Don Hollander, our retiring General Manager.

Don was recruited and contracted as the first APTLD General Manager in June 2006 at a time when our organisation was going through a period of retraction, with reducing membership numbers and low attendance at APTLD meetings. Don was instrumental in turning this situation around, making APTLD meetings far more popular with members, with vibrant and relevant agendas and speakers, resulting in significant increases in member attendance, and the highlight of more than 110 attendees at the Kuala Lumpur meeting earlier this year.

Our membership numbers have also grown substantially due to Don's hard work in recruiting ccTLDs and associate members in the region. We are grateful for these fantastic results, which now mean that more than half the ccTLDs in the region are members of APTLD.


Don has also projected APTLD as a serious voice for ccTLD operators within ICANN and other global and regional forums. Much of the progress within ICANN of the IDN Fast Track process for ccTLDs has been as a result of Don's leadership.

On behalf of the APTLD Board and members I extend our thanks to Don. We are delighted with the results of your efforts. As Don prepares to move on, we are aware we will miss him. I am sure I speak on behalf of all members wishing Don very well for whatever future endeavours he follows. Don will leave a gap at APTLD that will be a challenge to fill.

That said, we are delighted that Ramesh Kumar Nadarajah of Malaysia has agreed to become our next General Manager. Ramesh had been the Chair of APTLD several years ago. We are confident that he will build on the work that Don has done and will take APTLD to the next step and fulfil our vision that all members of APTLD will operate world class ccTLDs.

Financials

At the end of 2008, APTLD has an operating deficit of USD12,750 which is USD34,300 better than budgeted and nearly USD5,000 better than last year. Members will see that the financial results, while not quite where we want them, are better than we had planned. This was due to better than expected income from membership (Ordinary and Associate) and lower than expected expenses. The Board has taken active steps during the year to ensure that 2009 will be even better.



Co-operations

APTLD has very limited resources, and while Don has done some fantastic things, he is still only one person. We have taken an approach of working with partners, and there's no shortage of those to thank.

- Afilias and Neustar for their constant support of our meetings.
- APNIC for their participation in the ADRP Technical Workshop.
- ICANN and Delta-Risk for their participation in the ADRP Management Workshops.
- InternetNZ for their service as the Secretariat
- The members of the Board
- The other Regional Organisations (AfTLD, CENTR & LACTLD) plus the ccNSO and ISOC for their active participation in our programs and ongoing commitments to future partnerships.
- TWNIC, MYNIC and NIXI for their generous contributions as local hosts to our meetings this year.

Looking into 2009

In 2009, APTLD hopes to continue to facilitate sharing of knowledge and experience of members, in particular with a view to achieve best practice. In addition to meetings, we plan to conduct more surveys this year, based on the findings of the comprehensive member survey conducted in 2008.

Although we have planned for two members' meetings in 2009, we would like to have your view on the need for a third meeting.



In relation to policy development affecting ccTLDs, there will continue to be work required on IDN ccTLD and potentially the new gTLD process. As the IDN ccTLD Fast Track implementation plan is coming to finalisation and a schedule for its introduction will be available soon, we shall inevitably be involved in the PDP for the IDN ccTLD.

We shall also review the membership fee bands and the 'self-select' approach to determine membership fees by the members themselves. Some members have raised questions concerning these in relation to how APTLD will deploy its funds to achieve its mission and objectives in the coming years. Members' views are most welcome.

And finally, I would like to thank our members for their contributions and participation in our activities. It is because of you that we are here and it's you and your interests that we serve.

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

1. General

Persatuan Domain Peringkat Pertama Asia Pasifik [Asia Pacific Top Level Domain Association], is an organisation for country code Top Level Domain registries in Asia Pacific region, originally established in 1998 and incorporated as a society on 19th February 2004 under registration number 0314-04-5, with an address at 6th Floor, Yee Seng Building, 15 Jalan Raja Chulan, 50200 Wilayah Persekutuan Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia ("APTLD").

APTLD works as the forum of information exchange regarding technological and operational issues of domain name registries in Asia Pacific region. Also, as an interface to other international internet coordinating bodies, APTLD fosters and elevates participation of Asia Pacific country-code level domians in the global fora, as well as acting in the best interest of APTLD members in the global internet policy making process. APTLD is based on membership, and its activities are funded by membership fees. In 2005, APTLD relocated its office to New Zeland and has no employees.

2. Basis of Presentation

Measurement Base

The general accounting policies recognised as appropriate for the measurement and reporting of results and the financial position and unless otherwise stated is historic cost.

The accompanying financial statements of APTLD have been prepared on the accurals basis.

3. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

Revenue Recognition

Membership incomes are recognised when the payments are received.

4. Cash

As of 31 December all the cash of APTLD represents bank deposits.
